The Wabauunsee County Fair is one of the highlights of the 4-H year! There are many deadlines and rules to follow, so pay close attention to the 4-H newsletter. Here are some of the deadlines to watch for:

- May 1st Horse ID Papers Due
- Early July Fair Work Day
Pre-entries Due
King & Queen Applications Due
- Monday before Fair Clothing & Fashion Revue Judging at Mission Valley High School
Dog Show
- Saturday before Fair Fair Set-Up
- Tuesday (Fair End) Clean-Up
- Friday after Fair State Fair Entries Due

As of the 2011 County Fair, pre-entries included beef, sheep, swine, goat, rabbit, poultry, horse, hand pet (including posters), dog, clothing construction and fashion revue, King and Queen. As a good rule of thumb, just remember everything with a heartbeat (all animals), clothing, and King and Queen. Pre-entry forms are available from the Extension Office late-Spring.

If a project does NOT require a pre-entry, members will submit a 4-H Exhibit Card with their project at check-in. Here is an example of that card:
