# North Building Project

The Wabaunsee County Fair Association is continually improving and updating the Fairground's facilities. The next focus of the long range plan is the North Building. The current building is in poor condition as the roof leaks, there are electrical issues, the bathrooms need updated, and the doors are difficult to maneuver. With these issues the building is not being used to it's full potential.

The Fair Association has formed a committee to seek funding and develop a building design to replace the current North Building. The proposed building will meet the needs of the Wabaunsee County Fair, as well as provide multiple opportunities for hosting various county and state-wide events. With 4-H membership increasing, this will provide a space for safe, educational, and fun project experiences.

The Building Committee is proposing this project be completed in two phases:

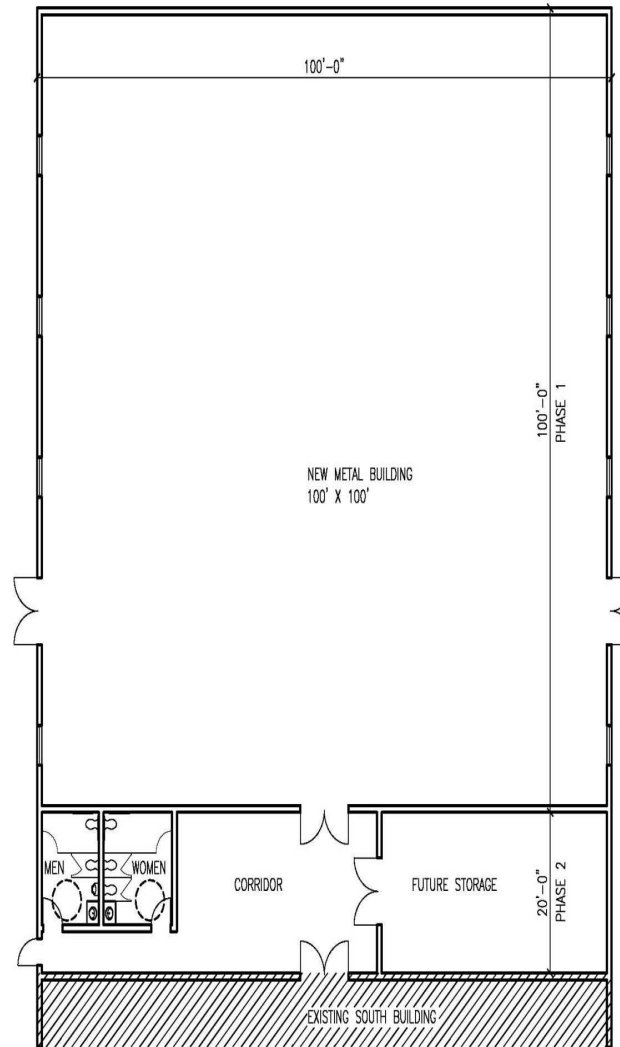
## Phase I

This includes a 100 x 100 foot metal, insulated building containing central air and two 4- foot doors on both the east and west sides of the building. The estimated cost is approximately \$200,000.

## Phase 2

An addition between the new North Building and the current South Building will be included in this phase. The enclosed space will contain bathrooms and storage for chairs, tables, display cases, and other supplies. The estimated cost is approximately \$100,000.
