

#### 2025 Livestock Tagging Information

All animals that may be shown at either County or State 4-H events must be tagged. **Tagging is by family, animals do NOT have to be designated to a 4-Her until FairEntry submission, June 6 – July 1!** 

<u>BEEF</u> – Including Bucket Calves, Commercial Heifers & Market Heifers/Steers

Weigh-In & Tagging: March 2; 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. Jones Family Angus

Beef Tagging Deadline: April 15, 2025; 5:00 p.m.

GOAT, SHEEP, SWINE – All species together to include Commercial & Market Animals

Weigh-In & Tagging: April 26; 8:00 – 10:00 a.m. Wabaunsee County Fairgrounds

Goat, Sheep & Swine Tagging Deadline: May 23, 2025; 5:00 p.m.

#### Horse ID Certificates - NEW 2025 FORM

The Kansas 4-H Horse Certificate (P1039) has been updated for the 2024-25 4-H program year. All ID certificates in the office will not be valid for the new year. A copy of the new certificate has been mailed with a letter from the office to all members currently enrolled and those enrolled last year in the horse project. Please complete the new Kansas 4-H Horse Certificate and bring by the Extension Office to be signed and copied. If you need assistance, please contact Stephanie (snmaike@ksu.edu). Families must maintain the ORIGINAL certificate. Registration papers WILL NOT be accepted to identify horses for the 4-H Horse project. 4-H Horse Certificates are due to the Extension office no later than June 1, 2025.

#### Kansas 4-H Horse Judging Contest

The 2025 Kansas 4-H Horse Judging Contest will be held **March 21**, in conjunction with EquiFest of Kansas in Salina.

The Kansas 4-H contest is open to youth members ages 9-18 and the open contest, hosted by the Kansas Quarter Horse Association, is open to youth of any age. Youth competing in the 4-H contest may also participate in the open contest.

If you are interested in participating, please contact the Extension Office by February 28. The cost to participate is \$25 for the 4-H contest and \$15 for the open contest. Registration must be done by county, please do not register yourself.

#### Kansas 4-H Horse Panorama

The Kansas 4-H Horse Panorama is a compilation of various contests related to the Horse Project. Contests include: quiz bowl, hippology, public speaking presentations, photography and educational posters. Registration includes housing and meals at Rock Springs, as well as contest fees.
