
2025 Rock Springs 4-H Camp

Please contact the office early to schedule the EID tagging of your STATE ONLY animals. Nominations must be postmarked by their deadline. Stay up-to-date with the State Nomination details here.

2025 Livestock Tagging Information

All animals that may be shown at either County or State 4-H events must be tagged. **Tagging is by family, animals do NOT have to be designated to a 4-Her until FairEntry submission, June 6 – July 1!**

<u>BEEF</u> – Including Bucket Calves, Commercial Heifers & Market Heifers/Steers

Weigh-In & Tagging: March 2; 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. Jones Family Angus

Beef Tagging Deadline: April 15, 2025; 5:00 p.m.

GOAT, SHEEP, SWINE – All species together to include Commercial & Market Animals

Weigh-In & Tagging: April 26; 8:00 – 10:00 a.m. Wabaunsee County Fairgrounds

Goat, Sheep & Swine Tagging Deadline: May 23, 2025; 5:00 p.m.



To cut down on the amount of travel staff does for individual livestock tagging, the staff are looking at alternative options for families if the county-wide tagging days don't work in your schedule. Please contact Stephanie (snmaike@ksu.edu) to schedule. NO TAGGING WILL BE DONE DURING SPRING BREAK (MARCH 14 – 23). Stay tuned for additional tagging opportunities.



Horse ID Certificates - NEW 2025 FORM

The Kansas 4-H Horse Certificate (P1039) has been updated for the 2024-25 4-H program year. All ID certificates in the office will not be valid for the new year. Please complete the new Kansas 4-H Horse Certificate and bring by the Extension Office to be signed and copied. If you need assistance, please contact Stephanie (snmaike@ksu.edu). Families must maintain the ORIGINAL certificate. Registration papers WILL NOT be accepted to identify horses for the 4-H Horse project. 4-H Horse Certificates are due to the Extension office no later than June 1, 2025.

Additionally, the 4-H Horse Show Rulebook is being revised. The office will be ordering when they are released. Please let Stephanie (snmaike@ksu.edu) by **December 15,** know if you would like a copy. 4-H Horse Show Rulebooks have historically been around \$7.

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) Training

Any youth planning to show at a State or National show must be YQCA certified. All members are strongly encouraged to become certified. At this time, no in-person trainings have been scheduled. If there is enough interest, Stephanie would consider offering one in the early Spring.
