### **Beef Meeting in Alta Vista**

The 2016 Winter Ranch Management Seminar Series is coming to Alta Vista on February 2<sup>nd</sup>. The format of the 2016 Winter Ranch Management Seminar Series is a face-to-face meeting with a series of short presentations focused on beef production management and a ‘Town Hall’ question and answer session where producers can ask their questions to extension specialists.
