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Medicare Open Enrollment

Are you currently on Medicare? Do you have a prescription drug plan? If you are answering yes to one of these questions, then the enrollment might be for you. The enrollment period for Prescription Drug Plans is October 15th – December 7th. The plans enrolled in during this period will take effect January 1, 2016. Persons with Medicare are encouraged to compare prescription drug plans each fall during the Open Enrollment Period.

As Senior Health Insurance Counselors for Kansas, we objectively compare drug plans and provide education about your options for the coming year. The decision of which drug plan to choose ALWAYS remains with you!

I am a certified Senior Health Insurance Counselor for Kansas (SHICK) and I am willing to assist Medicare beneficiaries with shopping to find the best prescription drug plan.
